Contour interval: 100 feet—east of the Missouri River and to the 1800-foot contour west of the Missouri River, 200 feet from the 1800-foot contour to the 4000-foot contour in the Black Hills, 400 feet interval above the 4000-foot contour.
Contours 1000, 1500, 2000, 3000, 4000, 6000 and 7000 are in heavy lines.
